Call to Order

Approval/Addition of Agenda

Board Workshop

Geographic Information Systems (GIS)

Director Stolsig provided updates on departmental activities, noting primary projects included parcel edits; adding or editing address points; and, a review of fire district boundaries and precinct edits. Additionally, Stolsig reported he is currently reviewing what other counties are using for their digital mapping.

Emergency Management

Director Duffey reported that November projects included Columbia Generating System (CGS) basic radiation training; CGS WISE training; submission of ESF 10, LEPC plan to EMD; and, BESS (battery energy storage section) Code. Additionally, Duffey reported CodeRED was hacked with the department using a backup while the service is down.

Central Services

Director Igbinoba provided updates on Duo Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA), noting the pilot has been successful, with 85% of county employees now enrolled and actively using the system. Igbinoba requested and received Board **consensus to proceed with full countywide implementation of Duo Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) beginning Wednesday, December 17, 2025.**

Additionally, Igbinoba provided updates on the deployment of a new enterprise-grade perimeter router and VMare-carbon-black based network Intrusion Detection and Prevention Systems (NDIS/NIPS). The upgrade enhances the county's ability to detect and block sophisticated threats in real time.

Certain software license annual renewals have been completed.

Law and Justice Council

Judge Palubicki reviewed a proposed resolution for the purpose of updating the composition of the Law and Justice Council. A resolution will be finalized for adoption.
